Rules

• One entry per participant (all rights to the story remain property of the author).

- Entries must be original works by the entrant.
 - Plagiarism will result in disqualification.

How do I know if my work is original?

Original works offer new and different stories than what has already been created by others. This means that you are the author of the work, and the work is not copied from someone else's original work.

Can I use AI to create my submission?

At this time, we do not consider any work created using AI tools or that incorporates content generated by AI tools to be your original work.
